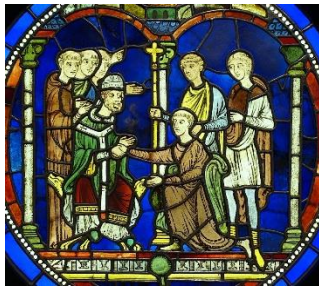

Fr Tom McElhone came to Deal as a curate in 1942. He came 'on loan' from the diocese of Elphin in Ireland. He moved to Kingston in 1943 and tragically drowned swimming in the Thames on 31 May 1944. His nephew, also Fr Tom McElhone, is a priest of our diocese and currently parish priest of St Thomas of Canterbury, Rainham, Kent. He will celebrate Mass here on Wednesday 7 June at 12 noon in memory of and in honour of his late uncle who began his priestly ministry in our parish. The younger Fr Tom came to Southwark in 1974, the last of the Elphin priests to come on the 'English Mission' to Southwark.

Fr Eamonn Whelan was our parish priest before Fr Duncan. He died in 2016. He was ordained priest on 11 June 1983 – 40 years ago. Let us remember him especially this 11 June and give thanks to God for his years of priestly ministry. May he rest in peace.

Friends of the Holy Land - Giving Hope to Vulnerable Christians: 25 years ago, a priest set up the first special school for children with learning disabilities in the West Bank and who were excluded from other schools and deemed impossible to teach. Today 60 children experience love, acceptance and an education at the **School of Joy**. The school receives no state funding and relies on the generosity of donors to exist. £25 pays for a child's nutritious school dinners for a month. £50 covers a year's medical insurance for one student. £100 funds one student at the school for a month. A Prayer for Peace & Justice

The Most Holy Trinity: a really determined effort to try to be more conscious of the presence of the Trinity in us can make a great difference in our spiritual life. Take the sign of the cross as an illustration of this. The sign of the cross expresses our faith in the mysteries of the Trinity (Father, Son & Holy Spirit) and the Cross/Crucifixion of Our Lord. It is the briefest act of adoration and faith in these two great mysteries and also in that of the indwelling Trinity. It reminds us of the connection between them and that Jesus on the Cross is the Way to the Blessed Trinity - we enter the life of the Trinity through Him and His Cross.
